

WAX RECOMMENDATION

Saturday January 12

1.5K Classic Sprint, 5K Classic Citizens

Race Start 9:30AM Women, 10:15AM Men

Citizens Race 11AM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday: Mostly cloudy, with a high near 17. Friday Night: Mostly cloudy, with a low around 3. North northwest wind between 5 and 7 mph. Saturday: Partly sunny, with a high near 15. Northwest wind around 7 mph. Overnight low: 3F Race time temperature: 8-12F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/XCold, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax White.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
