

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Collegetown, MN, St John's University Trails

Sunday January 13

6K, 12K Freestyle

Race Start 1PM

Mass Start, Multi Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night low 6F. Sunday high 19F.
Slight chance of snow over night and during the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Blue, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
