

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Iola Norseman Challenge

Iola, WI

Sunday January 27

10K Classic 9:30AM

18K Freestyle Noon

Forecast/Conditions: Friday low around 13, Saturday high around 30.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/Red, mixed 1:1 (Skate. Use HF Blue for Classic), scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax Blue, or Viola for more kick.

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
