

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Marine/O'Brian Ski Race

Marine on St. Croix, MN

Sunday January 27

12.5K or 25K

Race Start Classic 10:30AM, Skate 11AM, Kids 1:30 PM

One or Two Laps

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low of 13F. Saturday high of 34F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Blue, mixed 2:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax Blue, or Violet for more kick.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
