

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Blue Hills Ascent

Bruce, WI

Saturday January 5

2K Classic Sprint- 9:30AM

Kids Race- 11:20 AM

12K Free- Noon

8K Free (high school and youth)- 12:20PM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low 22F with 75% cloud cover. Saturday high near 36F, partly cloudy.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sand paper, and iron in TOKO BaseWax Green. Cover with 2-3 layers of Toko Carbon Viola. Those needing extra kick should use Toko Carbon Red.

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
