

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Waukesha Citizens Race

Nashotah Park, Waukesha, WI

Saturday, January 5

5 & 12K Freestyle

Race Start 11:30AM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday Night...Chance of freezing drizzle. Low temperature around 28. Saturday... Mostly cloudy with a chance of drizzle. Afternoon highs around 40.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow (2:1 mix), scrape and brush. Prepare base with yellow side of Dual Pad. Finish by applying HelX Cold, and polish with white side of Dual Pad after HelX is dry.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A warm universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions. If using the Structurite tool, make 1 pass with the course broken structure bit, covered by 1 pass with the fine linear bit.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
