

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

24th Annual Sawtooth Cross Country Ski Races

Grand Marais, MN

Sunday January 6

10K Classic, 20K Skate

Race Start 10AM Classic, 11AM Skate

Self Seeded Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night mostly cloudy, low 30°F.
Sunday, chance of rain/snow high 35F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO Base Green. Cover with Carbon Red, Carbon Silver may be needed for more kick.

Structure: A warm universal structure or a single pass with the light linear wheel of a Structurerite tool will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
