Forecast/Conditions: This course of manmade snow will have been rained on, frozen and worked with a PistenBully prior to the race. We expect the usual fine grooming work to produce a firm track with heavily transformed crystals. Friday evening temperature is expected to dip into the low teens, rise to the low 20s for the qualification round and settle into the low 30s for the heats. Expect calm wind, partly sunny skies and a slight chance of snow during the races.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. We are mixing in the Blue to harden the bases for the manmade snow which is usually aggressive and dirty.

Structure: A universal grind covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool before JetStream application should best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
