

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **You Name It Race**

Woodland Trails, Elk River, MN

Saturday, December 22, 2007

20Km and 10km Freestyle

Races Start at 10AM

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Thaw/freeze cycles Thursday and Friday. Friday evening.....lows forecasted for the upper teens, snow likely. Saturday... race time temperature forecast to be in the upper teens. Thirty percent chance of snow during the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1 mixture of HF Blue and HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, followed by a thermo pad or dual pad. HeIX Cold would make an excellent alternative to Jetstream in this case.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine to universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
