

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Winter Solstice Pursuit

Troll Hollow, Dresser, WI

Saturday, December 22, 2007

7Km - two loops classic, then two loops skate

Race Start 7:30PM

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: **Saturday daytime:** steady temperatures from 20-25 F. In excess of 500 high school skiers competing in the Holiday Relays during the day should produce a soft track and skating lane. **Saturday evening:** Race time temperatures in the middle teens. Chance of snow 25%.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1 mixture of HF Red and HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking (JetStream Moly for skate race and Jet Stream High Speed for the classic), and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, followed by a thermo pad or dual pad. HeIX Cold would make a great alternative to JetStream in this race.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with 2-3 layers of Toko Carbon White. Those needing extra kick may wish to use Carbon Blue.

Structure: A universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
