

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Hoigaard's Holiday Classic

Theodore Wirth Park, Minneapolis, MN

Sunday December 23, 2007

11K classic

Race Start 9:30AM

Interval starts (2X30 sec)

Forecast/Conditions: **Saturday:** Mostly cloudy. Highs in the 20s, chance of snow. **Saturday Night:** Mostly cloudy. Lows in the upper single digits. **Sunday:** Mostly cloudy with a chance of snow. Temperature at race time near 10 F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, followed by using either a thermo pad or dual pad.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with 2-3 layers of Toko Carbon White. Those needing extra kick or starting later may wish to use a Carbon Blue.

Structure: A fine to a fine-linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
