Snowflake Sprints

Snowflake Nordic, Duluth, MN

Sunday December 23, 2007

1K Skate Sprint

Qualification Round starts at 10:00AM

Heats follow immediately after qualification

Forecast/Conditions: **Saturday:** Mostly cloudy. Highs in the mid-20s, snow likely. **Saturday Night:** Mostly cloudy. Low 10-15.

Sunday: Mostly cloudy with a chance of snow. Race time temperature in the mid-teens.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1 mixture of HF Red and HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush followed by thermo pad or dual pad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine to a fine-linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
