

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Blueberry Hills Classic

Blueberry Hills Ski Trails, Deer River, MN

Saturday December 29, 2007

10K Classic

Race Start: 10:30AM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night's low around 5F with Saturday afternoon's high around 20F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue (1:1 mix), scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Follow by rotocorking JetStream High Speed Moly, polish well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with 2-3 layers of Toko Carbon White. Those needing extra kick may wish to use Carbon Blue.

Structure: A fine to fine-linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
