

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Wilderness Trek Ski Race

Hidden Valley Ski Center, Ely, MN

Saturday February 2

15K Continuous Pursuit, 7.5K Classic, 7.5K Skate

Race Start 11AM

Lap Course

Forecast/Conditions: Friday Night: A 20 percent chance of snow after midnight. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 14. South wind around 5 mph. Saturday: A 30 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 22. West wind between 5 and 10 mph. Race time temperature 19F after overnight low of 14F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax White, or Carbon Blue for more kick.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
