

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Lakeland Loppet

Minocqua Winter Park, Minocqua, WI

Saturday, March 1

8K Classic @ 9am

25K Freestyle @ 11am

Forecast/Conditions:

Friday Night...Mostly Cloudy with a 30% chance of snow, with a low around 2. **Saturday**...Mostly sunny with an afternoon high of around 31.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. Then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking Jetstream Moly, brushing afterwards with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a Thermopad.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with 2-3 layers of Toko Carbon White. Those needing extra kick should use Toko Carbon Blue.

Structure: A cold stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
