

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## ABR Spring Race

ABR Trails, Ironwood, MI

Sunday, March 16

19K freestyle race, also 6K youth & 3.5 Jr  
freestyle races

Races start 8:54-9:15AM

Forecast/Conditions: **Saturday**... mostly sunny, high near 30.

**Saturday Night**...Mostly cloudy. Lows around 11. **Sunday**...Mostly  
sunny, race time temperatures in the mid to high twenties.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1  
mixture of HF Blue/Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking  
JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing  
brush, followed by a thermopad. Helx Cold would be a good  
alternative to JetStream Moly.

Gripwax: na

Structure: A universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
