

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Twin Ports Championship

Snowflake Nordic Center – Duluth, MN

Saturday, March 8

4K classic and 4K skate pursuit races

Classic race starts at 10AM – Mass start

Skate race starts 11:30AM – Pursuit start

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday**...Mostly sunny, high near 10.

**Friday Night**...Partly cloudy. Lows near -5.

**Saturday**...Mostly cloudy with a 20% chance of snow. High in the upper teens.

Glidewax: Apply a mixture of LF Moly/Blue scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream High Speed for the classic race or JetStream Moly for the skate race, polish well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, followed by a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with several layers of Carbon white kick wax. Carbon Blue may be used by those who desired more kick.

Structure: A fine-linear structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
