## **Bolton Season Opener**

Saturday, December 13

Men start 9:30 A.M., Women at 10:30 A.M.

5K Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night, mostly cloudy with a low around -2F. Saturday, mostly sunny with a high near 6F. Snow predicted Friday evening, up to 4-6 inches. Six inches of snow fell Thursday night. The course is tentatively planned to be two laps using World Cup and Broadway. There is a significant hill in World Cup. Later starters can encounter some softer conditions given the recent snowfall and despite very cold conditions predicted for tonight.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue and Nordlite Powder X-cold, scrape and brush well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and buff with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
