Noon Open Race

5K Freestyle

1-2 Laps

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 24, temperature at start will be about 35. Snow will be a mixture of wet semi-transformed snow and freezing rain, with a soft track. There will be cloud cover, with a 50 percent possibility of freezing rain.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and buff with a thermopad.

Structure: A Universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
