## **Craftsbury Spring Fling**

Craftsbury, VT

Saturday, March 7

10 A.M.

15K/30K Skate

Mass start, Self-seeded

15K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low temp 31, Saturday high in low 40s, sunny. The track will be PistenBully groomed and should be hard and fast in the morning, warming to wet snow by late morning. There is a good base and track is in excellent condition. Snow temp at race start should be in the low 30s.

Glidewax: Iron on LF Moly, scrape and brush. Then iron on HF Red/H Yellow mixed 1:2, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and buff with a thermopad.

Structure: Choose your warm grind skis or 2 passes of the coarse broken Structurite Tool after the HF wax and before applying the JetStream.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is
