

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **NYSEF Season Opener**

Mt. Van Hoevenberg, Lake Placid, NY

Sunday, December 14

Skate 5K for J2, 10K others

10:30 wave start according to age groups

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday, mostly sunny with a high near 16. Saturday night, partly cloudy with a low around 10. Sunday, mostly cloudy with a high near 32. Race time temperature near 15. Snow temperatures should remain in the teens.

Glidewax: Iron on LF Moly, scrape and brush. Then iron on HF Blue, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and buff with a thermopad.

Structure: Cold Stonegrind or one pass with Toko Structurite on Fine Linear before corking on the Jetstream.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
