

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Mountain Top and Tippmann Paintball Biathlon

Mt. Top Inn & Resort, Chittenden, VT

Saturday, January 24, 5 P.M., adults and high school division

Sunday, January 25, 10 A.M., BKL division

Skate

Interval start, 15 seconds. 100 to 150 skiers

Multiple small loops with stops in the shooting corral depending on age class

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday, mostly sunny with high near 21. Saturday night, partly cloudy with a low around -13 F. Sunday, mostly sunny with a high near 12. Packed powder conditions -- should be excellent, hard, cold snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, sprinkle on Nordlite Powder X-cold, iron in together, scrape and brush. Finish by lightly applying JetStream Blue, cork lightly and polish with thermopad.

Structure: A cold stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
