Forecast/Conditions: Friday night clear with a low around 10. Saturday, sunny, warming to 34. Snow temp should be in 20s.

Glidewax: Iron on LF Moly, scrape, and brush. Then iron on HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A Universal grind or a fine linear structure, covered by two passes with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO Structurite tool (before JetStream application), will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
