Classic 25K, Skate 25K/50K

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low 20 with chance of rain and then snow showers. Saturday high of 39, sunny. Snow temp will be upper 20s to 32.

Glidewax: Iron on LF Moly, scrape and brush. Iron on HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking or ironing JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen the kick zone with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply a very thin layer of Carbon Klister Base Green. Mix Klister MultiViola and Klister Orange 1:1 in a thin layer. Cover with Carbon GripWax Yellow if there is fresh snow.

Structure: Use a new, wet snow grind or 2 passes of the coarse broken Structurite Tool after the HF wax and before applying the JetStream.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
