

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Event Name: Rangeley Opener

Rangeley Lakes, ME

Saturday, December 27

Women 11 A.M., Men Noon, Open 1 P.M.

5K skate

Interval start

1 Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low around 15F, race time temperatures in the upper 20s to around 30, Saturday high of 33F. Chance of snow Friday night and a 90 percent chance of freezing rain on Saturday. There is a good base. Expect snow temps in the mid 20s at 11 A.M. and near 32 for the Open race. Expect a lot of moisture in the snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and buff with a thermopad. Open racers should change to HF Red/Yellow mixed 1:1 and JetStream Yellow.

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the fine-offset wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit earlier starters. Open racers should use more aggressive structure.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
