

WAX RECOMMENDATION TOKO®

The Bogburn

Pomfret, VT

Saturday, January 10

9:45 BKL, 12:30 Women and J2, 1:30 Men

Classic 12K for Men, 6K for Women and Juniors

Interval start, 1 6K lap

Old-style, fun trail through the woods

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low 0 to -3F. Light snow during the day Saturday with a high of 15. Pole track often soft so use larger baskets if you have them.

Glidewax: Iron on LF Moly, scrape and brush. Then iron on HF Blue, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, smooth with a cork, let cool. Apply 3-4 layers of Toko GripWax Viola, corking between each layer. Check at the TOKO tent for updated grip wax recommendation.

Structure: A fine linear structure, created by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
