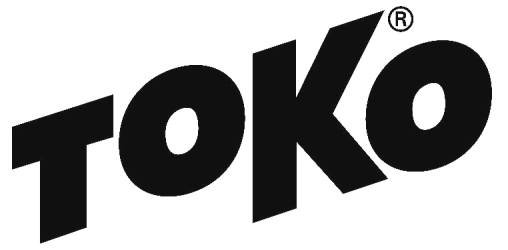


# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## ICHEBOD'S REVENGE

Sleepy Hollow Nordic Center, Huntington, VT

Sunday, February 15

10 A.M. BKSL, Wave start by age class

11 A.M., 10K Classic, Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night, partly cloudy with a low around 14. Sunday, partly sunny with a high near 24. Chief groomer says "good coverage with some dirty spots." 3 laps of 3K+ loop so track will get glazed as race goes on.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. If putting on top coats, finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon Klister Base Green. Apply Carbon Klister Multiviola. Bring Carbon GripWax Viola for possible cover over klister, depending on grooming technique.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
