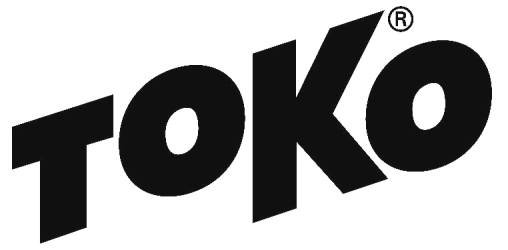


# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Stowe Derby

Mt. Mansfield to Stowe Village, VT

Sunday, February 22

9 A.M., 6K, Mass start

10 A.M., 19K Skate, Wave start

Noon, 19K Classic, Wave start

Waves of 5 every :30

Forecast/Conditions: Snow flurries for several days should provide wonderful powder conditions! Overnight low 15, rising to mid 20s by classic race finish; cloudy, flurries. Classic course will be scrapped to hard crust on downhills. Track will be regroomed with fresh classic tracks from MMTC to finish.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue for skate race, HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1 for classic. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue for skate, JS Red for classic, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Temps in teens and 20s all week may keep the snow from packing firmly, requiring tough binder on scrapped off downhill turns. Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Cork in several layers of Carbon Viola.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
