

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **NENSA J2 FESTIVAL**

Holderness School, Plymouth, NH

Saturday, March 14

10 A.M., 5K Classic

2 P.M., 1.2K Skate Sprint

Seeded wave start

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 23, temp at classical start 28, sunny. Expect wet granular snow. Temp at sprint start 38.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. For Classic, apply HF Red, scrape and brush. For Sprint, apply HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red (Classic) or JS Yellow (Sprint), brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

GripWax: Roughen the kick zone with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply a very thin layer of Carbon Klister Base Green. Early starters: apply Toko Sportline Klister Universal; later starters: Carbon Klister Orange; latest starters: Klister Orange mixed with Klister Silver if more kick is needed.

Structure: Warm grind skis with two passes of the Coarse Offset bit of a TOKO Structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
