

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Harry Eldridge Memorial

Mt. Van Hovenberg, Lake Placid, NY

Sunday, January 25

10 A.M.

10K Skate (women), 15K Skate (men)

Wave start by age group, 100 to 150 skiers

2 loops

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday, cloudy and cold, low -24 F.
Sunday, cloudy, 30 percent chance of snow, high of 4 F. Snow temp at start in the teens with a packed powder surface over a hard base. Track is rolling, mostly in the woods and will be set with a PistenBully. Race start may be delayed until temperature increases.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, sprinkle on Nordlite Powder X-cold, iron together, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A cold stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
