

WAX RECOMMENDATION



NENSA/TD Bank Bill Koch Festival

Starks Hill, Fryeburg, ME (moved from Pineland)

Sunday, February 28

Individual Skate starting with Grades 1 & 2 mixed gender at 10 A.M., and aging up. Last start at 1:30 P.M. with Grades 7 & 8 Boys.

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night chance of snow showers, cloudy, with low of 26. Precipitation chance is 40 percent. Sunday chance of snow showers, cloudy, with high near 37. Chance of precipitation is 50 percent.

Glidewax: Option 1: Apply System 3 Red/Yellow mixed 1:1 for early starters and straight Yellow for afternoon starters. Option 2: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then for morning starters apply HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking Jet Stream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. For later starters, apply HF Yellow, scrape and brush, rotocork JS Yellow, brush and polish.

Structure: One pass with TOKO Structurite tool using Red wheel in the a.m. and Yellow wheel in p.m. (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
