

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Winona Forest Tourathon

Pulaski, NY

Saturday, March 6

9 A.M.

12.5K/25K/37.5K Classic

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night, clear, low around 17. Saturday mostly sunny, high 42. Race temperature around 24 at start warming to 40s. A lot of snow that is about a week old, not yet transformed.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow, scrape and brush. Use Yellow Structurite Tool one good pass. Iron in JetStream Yellow one pass with iron. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply Klister Universal, let cool, then cover lightly with Carbon GripWax Viola.

Structure: One pass with the Yellow wheel of a TOKO Structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
