

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## TD Bank Eastern J2 Champs/National Invitational

Jackson Nordic Center, Jackson , NH

Saturday, March 6

2 P.M.

Classical 1.1K Sprint

Seeded wave start

**Forecast/Conditions:** Friday night mostly clear with a low around 16. Slightly transformed new snow, machine groomed with low base. Temperature at start will be high 30s and sunny.

**Glidewax:** Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, iron in very thin layer of Carbon Klister Base Green, let cool. Apply Carbon Klister Orange mixed with Klister Silver, test different ratios for optimal glide and kick.

**Structure:** A universal grind covered by one pass with the Yellow TOKO Structurite tool (old coarse offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
