

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## NYSEF NRL/ Mid-Atlantic JOQ

Mt Van Hoevenberg, Lake Placid, NY

Sunday January 20

10 am individual start

Skate race; 7.5 k for everyone.

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday Night: A chance of snow showers. Cloudy, with a low around -1. Chance of precipitation is 50%. Sunday: A chance of snow showers. Partly sunny and cold, with a high near 1. Chance of precipitation is 30%.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/XCold Powder, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by polishing well with a horse hair brush.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeiX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
