

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

John Sackett Memorial Classic Race

Mt Hor, Westmore, VT

Sunday January 20

10K Classic

Race Start 12:00PM

Interval Start, 2 Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Friday: 80% chance of snow. Saturday: 40% chance of snow, high 21 F, low 1 F Sunday, 30% chance of snow, high of 4 F. The track is in the woods, rolling with a long climb in each lap. The trail will have a good hard base, that will be groomed with a soft powder surface.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue, mixed 1:1, add a layer of LF Blue to harden base, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/XCold, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by, brushing with a dedicated horse hair polishing brush.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with two layers TOKO Carbon Gripwax Mint.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
