

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Valley Cup Freestyle

Airport Road, Warren, VT

Sunday January 27

10K, J1 and J2 5K

Race Start 10AM

Freestyle

Forecast/Conditions: **Saturday:** Mostly cloudy, with a high near 24. **Saturday Night:** A chance of snow showers. Cloudy, with a low around 14. Chance of precipitation is 50%. **Sunday:** Cloudy, with a high near 30

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
