

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **NYSEF Season Opener**

Mt Van Hoevenberg, Lake Placid, NY

Saturday December 8

Skate/wave starts/5 k for all J2s, 10 k all

others; lollipop 0.5 k, J5 1k, J4 2k and J3 3k

Race Start 10AM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night chance of snow showers, cloudy with low of 17F. Chance of precipitation is 30%; Saturday chance of snow showers; mostly cloudy with high near 28. Chance of precipitation is 30%. Race skis are a safe bet.

Glidewax: Iron in LF Moly as first layer, let cool to room temp, then scrape and brush. Next, iron in HF Red, cool, then scrape and brush. For fast final cover, Rotocork Jet Stream Moly Block, then brush lightly and polish with a thermopad. The base should appear shiny.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine/cold stonegrind on a soft ski, will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
