

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Vermont Academy Season Opener

5K Classic, Interval start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night; partly cloudy with LOW of 8F; Sunday, chance of snow, mostly cloudy with HIGH of 24F; chance of precipitation 30%. Track conditions: The track is mostly in the woods, and rolling. The loop will be 5 km long.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, apply HF Blue/Red mix, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polishing with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, and apply thin layer of TOKO basewax Green, and iron in. early starters recommended to test Carbon Blue.

Structure: A universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
