7.5K Classic Race

Race Start 9:30AM-Boys, 10:45-Girls

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday Night: A chance of snow or rain showers. Cloudy, with a low around 20. Chance of precipitation is 30%.

Sunday: A chance of snow or rain. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 34. Chance of precipitation is 30%.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply layer of HF Yellow/Red 1:1 mix, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream High Speed, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, then polish vigorously with thermo pad.

Gripwax: Prepare kick zone by sanding with 150 grit sandpaper and then applying Base Green binder. Because conditions are predicted to be in that 'wintery-mix' zone, it is impossible to make a final kick wax choice this far out without seeing the race day conditions. Consult Toko Representative at site.

Structure: A medium linear stone grind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
