

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

NW HS Championships/ JOQ

Mt Bachelor, OR

Saturday and Sunday, February 21 and 22

Skate: Saturday 10:50 A.M., 3K/5K

Classic: Sunday 9:30 A.M. 3K/7.5K

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low 29, mostly cloudy.
Saturday high 35, 40 percent chance of snow. Saturday night low 27,
chance of snow. Sunday high 34, snow likely.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. Same for both days.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 150 grit sandpaper. If snow accumulation is 3"+, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool, then apply 2 layers of Carbon Red or Carbon Yellow, corking between layers. If snow is less than 3", iron in Carbon Klister Base Green, apply 1 to 2 layers of Carbon Klister Orange.

Structure: Coarse grind recommended or two passes with the coarse offset wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.

Racing - Service
