## **Chicks On Sticks**

Leavenworth, WA

Sunday, February 8

9:30 A.M.

8K Skate

Mass Start

2 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 20, temp at start 25.

There is some chance of a little new snow Friday and Saturday, but the snowpack will remain primarily old granular snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

JetStream High Speed Moly would make excellent substitute for JetStream Red.

Gripwax: N/A.

Structure: Medium linear structure applied with one pass of the coarse linear wheel followed by one pass with fine linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
