

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Methow Valley Pursuit**

Winthrop, WA

Saturday, January 10

8:30 A.M. Mass start J5-7

9 A.M. Interval start J3-4

10 A.M. Interval start Pursuit Class

15K Pursuit, single lap

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 19 expected with some cloud cover. Snow temperature at race time should be near 24. Expect a very moisture-laden snowpack.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or the old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen the Kick zone with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon Klister Base Green, cork smooth, let cool. See Toko sign with recommendations prior to event in the starting area.

Structure: Universal structure or Nordic Ultratune's MVL or LJ03 grinds or one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
