

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

30K, Skate and Classic

Wave Start

Point to Point

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 10, snow temp at start in low teens with chance of snow. Current snowpack is abrasive granular snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue or old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 100 grit sandpaper. Iron in thin layer of Carbon Klister Base Green. Check the TOKO easel at the start area for updated grip wax recommendation.

Structure: Cold linear grind such as Nordic Ultratune 615b for skate or MVL for classic. A fine linear structure, done by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
