

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Race of the Methow

Winthrop, WA

Saturday, February 7

Skate Sprints

9 A.M. Qualifiers

11:45 A.M. Heats

Single lap, 1.3K (J1 thru Masters)

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 14 expected. Snow temperature at time trial should be near 16. Snow temp during the heats should be much warmer approaching mid to high 20s with a sunny day forecasted. Snow should be firm and fast!

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or the old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: Minimal structure such as one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. Nordic Ultratune's XC02 and 615B grinds have been running fast!

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
