

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Ski Rodeo

Mazama, Washington

Saturday, December 27

10:30 A.M. 1K/2.5K

11:30 A.M. 10K/5K

Freestyle, Mass Start

Single lap event

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 14 with snow likely before and during the event. Snow temperature at race time should be near 20. Expect soft pack conditions.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly or LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: Minimal structure such as one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. A softer flexed ski should work well after the past week's dry snowfall.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
