

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Race of the Methow

Winthrop, WA

Sunday, February 8

9 A.M. J3-7

10 A.M. J1 through Masters

10K Classic

3 laps of 3.3K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 14 expected. Snow temperature at race time should be near 18. Cloud cover is expected.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or the old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 100 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon Klister Base Green, let cool. Then apply Carbon Klister MultiViola, which should kick well unless we get a surprise snowfall.

Structure: Minimal structure such as one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. Nordic Ultratune's MVL grind has been running fast!

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
