Point to Point for Pursuit Racers

Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 22 expected with a chance of snow. Snow temperature at start should be near 24 with snow warmer near the finish in Winthrop.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or the old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: Universal structure or Nordic Ultratune's MVX grind or one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
