

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Spokane Pursuit / JOQ

Mt. Spokane Nordic Trails, Spokane, WA

Saturday, February 20

10 A.M.

5K/10K Classic

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday overnight low in the upper 20s. Temperature at start 30, sunny. Snow is granular.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 100 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon Klister Base Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply Klister MultiViola. If tracks are icy under trees add some Klister Silver under foot, or add Klister Orange if temperature rises more suddenly and tracks get moist.

Structure: A linear structure such as Nordic Ultratune MVL, LJ03 or one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
