## **Mt Bachelor New Years Day Relay**

Mt Bachelor, OR

Tuesday January 1

3X3K Relay

Race Start 10AM

Classic/Skate/Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Monday night expect lows near 15F, and partly cloudy skies. Tuesday, a high near 34 is expected, and mostly sunny.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by applying HelX Cold, and finally, buff with a dual pad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in Base Green Binder. Follow by applying 2 layers of Carbon Gripwax Blue, or Viola for more kick.

Structure: A universal structure on a medium flexing ski will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
