

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

The Great Nordeen

Mt Bachelor, OR

Saturday January 12

15K or 36K Freestyle

Race Start 9:30AM

Point to Point

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low 22, mostly cloudy, with snow showers. Saturday, high 34, mostly cloudy, with snow showers likely.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by preparing base with the yellow side of a TOKO Dual Pad, and then applying HeIX Cold. After allowing to dry completely, polish lightly with the white side of Dual Pad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
